Key investment in West London

- Rail
 - Crossrail operational by 2019
 - London Overground 5 car operation by 2016
 - Chiltern service capacity increase of 10% by 2019
 - New Overground stations in Old Oak Common in early by 2020's
 - HS2 by 2026
- Tube
 - Met & District line capacity increase of 27% by 2018
 - Jubilee line capacity increase of 17% by 2019
 - Piccadilly line new trains start coming into operation in 2022
- Bus
 - 800 new Routemasters for London by 2016
 - 3,400 hybrid buses in operation by 2019
 - Bus priority projects
- Roads
 - Better Junctions at Chiswick Roundabout and Hammersmith
 - Delivery of Cycle Superhighway and cycle quietway projects
 - Delivery of public realm projects outside Crossrail stations & at town centres

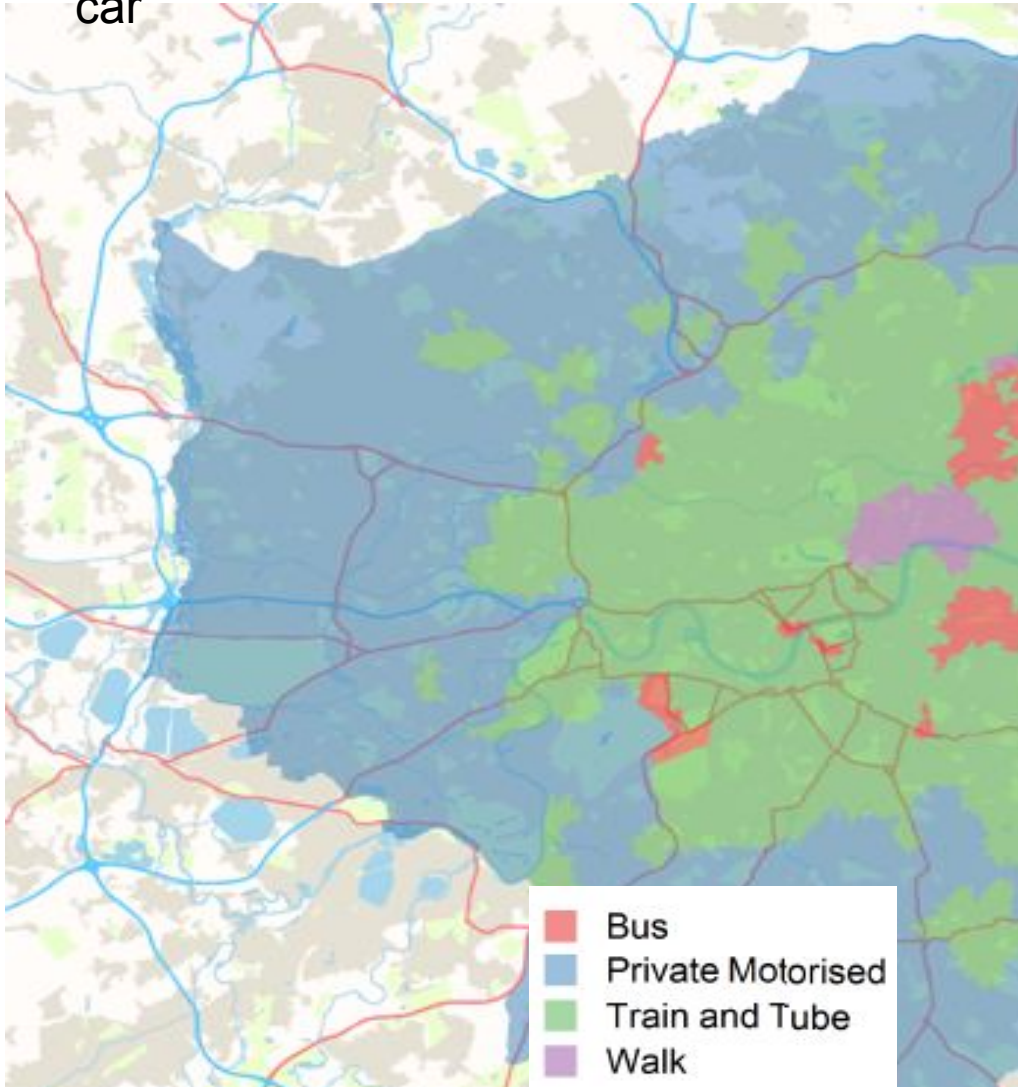

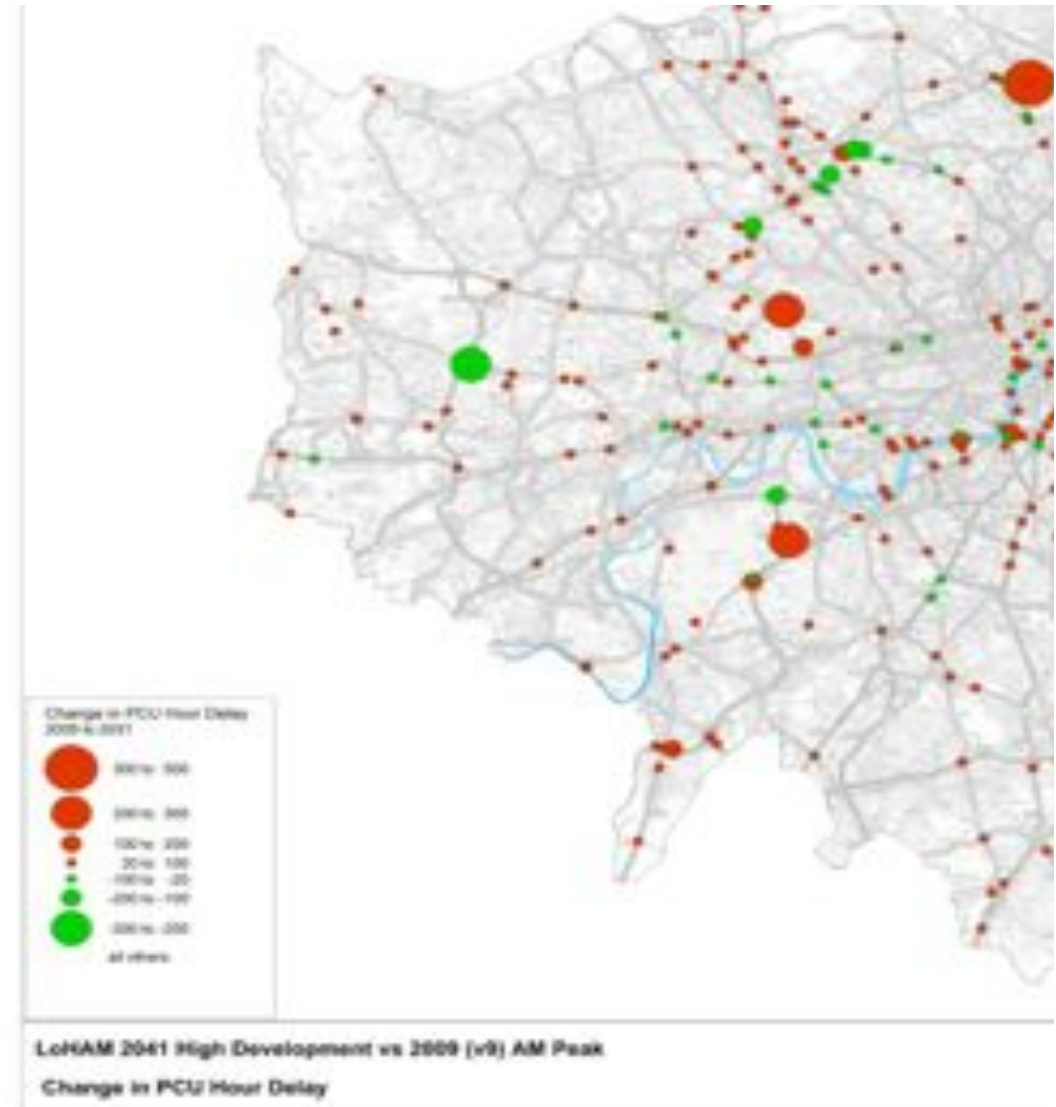
Crossrail helps address crowding problems on the tube network, although crowding is still set to increase by 2041

What does this mean in West London ?

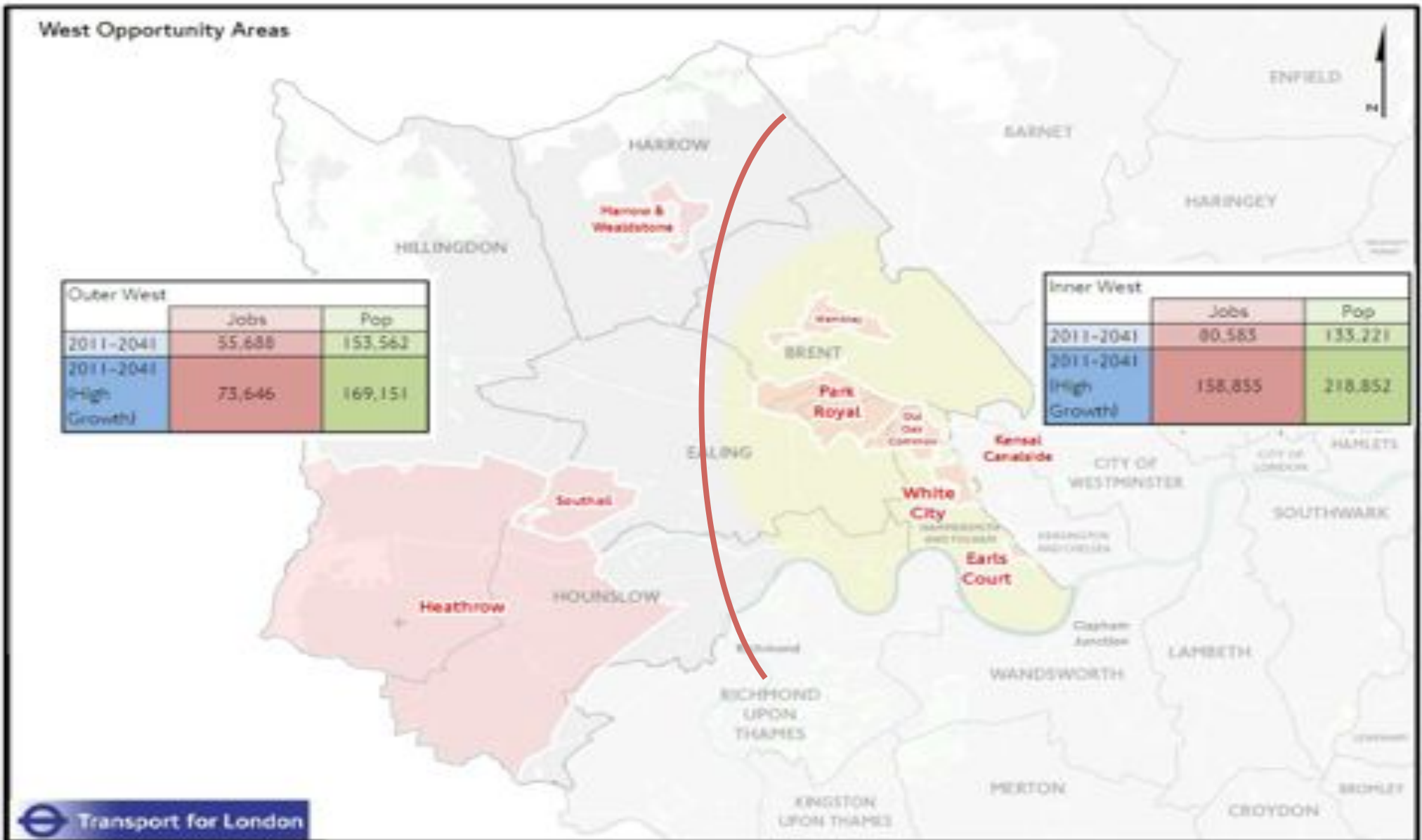
Most popular mode of travel to work is by car

Summary

London is growing at a fast pace and transport investment is essential to support this growth

There are a number of enhancement to public transport capacity planned in the region, the most important of which is Crossrail

Car is the dominant mode in West London and congestion is set to increase. Need to look at radical options, including flyunders/tunnels, to help address this issue.

There is a significant difference between inner and outer west London,

Opportunity Areas in West London are important concentrations of growth, however there is also significant growth likely across the region
